Energy Efficiency in Cold Weather:

Winter bills can add up, but there are simple ways to keep costs down. Weatherproof your windows and doors, use a programmable thermostat to control heating, and add extra insulation to keep your home cozy and energy-efficient this winter.

Winter Weather Tips:

With the cold of winter still with us, now is the perfect time to remind everyone to keep their water meters and utility access points clear of snow and ice. This helps prevent damage and ensures we can get to them quickly if needed. If you suspect frozen pipes or notice water main breaks, please report them to us right away.

Avoid Freezing Pipes:

When temperatures dip below zero, your pipes may be at higher risk of freezing. To minimize this risk, keep your thermostat at 58 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, and consider keeping your faucets dripping overnight. This keeps water moving in the pipes.
