Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chair Windsperger.

New Business

A. Collis Field Lights

Meghan Lange and Todd Wiens discussed the need for lights at Collis Field. There aren't lights currently and night games cannot be played there. Lights are estimated to cost anywhere between \$200,000 and \$300,000. They hope to have installed by the Spring of 2024 and will do fundraising for them. Concerns about light pollution were discussed. Residents adjacent to Collis Field will need to be consulted. Commissioners were generally supportive of installing lights at Collis Field. No action was taken.

Old Business

A. Vending Machine Proposal

Administrator Gronau reported that a suitable location for the vending machine at Marston Park could not be found.

1. New wood chips have been placed at most of the City's playgrounds.
2. The Collis Field scoreboard is not working. Staff is investigating.
